

PARKS IN THE CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE

- 1 Berkeley Mills Park is located near Asheville Highway at Berkeley Road. The nearly 60 acres was donated to the City by Kimberly Clark Corporation. Pavilions for rent. Connected to Oklawaha Greenway with parking.
- 2 Patton Park is the City's most active park with athletic courts, playing fields, skate park, outdoor pool, walking trails and greenway access. Pavilions for rent. Public restrooms, open seasonally.
- 3 Nestled in the Druid Hills Historic District, Keith Park offers greenspace and large mature trees.
- 4 The Oklawaha Greenway and Mud Creek Nature Trail connect the City's Berkeley Mills Park and Henderson County's Jackson Park. Educational signage on natural features enhance this trail. Parking is available at Patton Park, 7th Avenue with connections at Patton Park and Sullivan Park, Jackson Park, Berkeley Mills Park.
- 5 Fronting on Ashe Street off 7th Avenue, the J. H. Sullivan Park has 18 acres that include a playground, covered basketball courts, community garden and access to the Oklawaha Greenway. Public restrooms, open seasonally.
- 6 William H. King Memorial Park is located off 7th Avenue East near the Oklawaha Greenway and is home to the Hendersonville High School baseball team.
- 7 Boyd Park is located between King and Church Streets just north of Main Street. The miniature golf course is opened seasonally. Tennis Courts open year round.
- 8 Jackson Park, owned and operated by Henderson County, occupies 212 acres. Activities include sports fields, walking trail & picnic facilities. For information about this park, contact Henderson County at 828-697-4884.
- 9 Located on the corner of N. Grove Street and 4th Avenue East, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park provides greenspace with benches and picnic tables near downtown.
- 10 Tom's Park, on Lily Pond Road, occupies 2.5 acres. Provides nice greenspace.
- 11 Rotary Park, located on Allen Street along Wash Creek, has a shelter and several playground items.
- 12 Southside Park includes 14 acres south of downtown to be developed in the future.
- 13 Gateway Park was completed in 2011 and gives a green entrance to Main Street from the south end of town.
- 14 Lenox Park is a small City park located at the historic Lennox Spring on Whitted Street. This area has a picnic table and outdoor grill.
- 15 Henderson County Parks & Recreation, Athletics & Activity Center, 708 South Grove Street. For more information contact Henderson County at (828) 697-4884
- 16 Pet's Own Place, Dog Park, located at 1019 Seventh Avenue East, is a fenced dog park with two separate section for small and large dogs. There is also a waste bag dispenser, trash receptacle and a water spigot. The park is located across Mud Creek at the Oklawaha Greenway trail head. Parking is available off Seventh Avenue.
