

RESOLUTION ADOPTING HENDERSON COUNTY ANIMAL AND NOISE ORDINANCES

WHEREAS The City of Hendersonville is a body politic promoting public health, safety and welfare and preventing nuisances throughout its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS the City seeks to cooperate with other governing bodies to provide for the efficient enforcement of law.

WHEREAS adopting County ordinances provides consistency throughout the county regarding animal and noise issues;

WHEREAS consistent laws makes enforcement and public education easier for County and municipal residents and reduces confusion regarding the jurisdiction of certain laws and prohibitions;

WHEREAS common ordinances allow the County and the City to provide better, more uniform and more efficient services to our citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council as follows:

1. The City declares its intent to adopt the Henderson County Animal Ordinance 66A and Henderson County Noise Ordinance 125A.
2. The City adopts these Ordinances in their entirety as written.
3. The City agrees to the adoption any future amendments, modifications, or changes made to these Ordinances.
4. The City requests of the Henderson County Board of Commissioners the enforcement of these Ordinances within the municipal boundaries by Henderson County.
5. This resolution will be effective upon the date of adoption.
