# PROJECT SUMMARY

The City of Hendersonville is seeking a federal SS4A grant for the 7th Avenue Safety Implementation Project. This project will improve safety for all travel modes, contribute to the quality of life of area residents and visitors, enhance local connectivity, and promote small-town economic development through the provision of 0.4 miles of safer, convenient, and more beautiful 7th Avenue.

The 7th Avenue project will continue to advance safe and beautiful infrastructure that the City has already begun immediately west of this project. If funded, the project will expand safe and accessible pedestrian infrastructure, improve public safety, and boost Hendersonville's status as a regional economic and tourism hub. The project will incorporate modernized improvements while restoring the historic character of each corridor. These include stormwater best management practices, like permeable pavements and tree trenches, signal improvements, enhanced pedestrian crossings, and flexible spaces for gathering.
