MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 5

11am closure only impacts Southbound traffic (detour provided at Fleming St.)
Northbound traffic not impacted.

The King Apple Parade

On Monday, September 5, the King Apple Parade will be taking place in downtown Hendersonville at 2:30pm. Street closures beyond the Main Street festival closure will occur to accommodate the parade route and parade staging areas.

Street Closures:

-  Apple Festival / King Apple Parade Route - Closed Thursday September 1 at 2:00 pm
-  King Apple Parade Staging Area - Closed Monday September 5 at 11:00 am
-  Additional Parade Closures - Closed Monday September 5 at 2:15 pm

Street closures:

9/5 at 11 am:

- Southbound traffic traveling towards downtown on Asheville Hwy (US-25) will be diverted to Fleming St for Hwy 64 W and Church St connections.
- Church St will be closed from 5 points to 7th Ave W.
- Oakland St closed from Asheville Hwy (US-25) to 6th Ave W (US-64).
- Bearcat Blvd closed from Fleming St to N. Main St.
- Buncombe St closed from Bearcat Blvd to 7th Ave W.

9/5 at 2:15 pm:

- Immediately before the parade, additional portions of Main Street will close from its southern intersection with King Street to the N. Main Street intersection at 5 points for the parade route.
- Motorists approaching the parade area will be directed to a detour route.
- Commercial truck traffic traveling inbound on 4 Seasons Blvd (US-64) will be rerouted via Duncan Hill/Signal Hill to reach Asheville Hwy (US-25).

The streets will reopen following the completion of the parade and festival clean up.
