What does it mean to adopt a street?

By adopting a Hendersonville city street, your group, organization or school agrees to visit that street a minimum of once a month to help keep it clean, and to make note of any condition of the street that requires attention by City Maintenance employees.

By adopting a street and helping to keep it clean, you will be extending your tax dollars by allowing City employees to spend their time on major renovations, repairs and maintenance work.

You will also be able to take pride in the fact that you will be helping to make Hendersonville one of the most beautiful & pleasant cities in the Western North Carolina.

Who qualifies to adopt a street?

Local service clubs, sports teams, youth organizations, church congregations, schools, businesses, non-profits, families and friends are welcome and encouraged to adopt a street.

Youth organizations are required to have at least one adult supervisor while working at their adopted street.

What tasks are we volunteering to do by adopting a street?

Adoptive groups are asked to:

- Pick up litter
- **❖** Pick up tires

Groups are also asked to make note of:

- ✓ Vandalism damage
- ✓ Potholes
- ✓ Unsafe conditions

Adoptive groups are not expected to perform major repairs or maintenance.

What supplies will be provided?

The City of Hendersonville will provide the following materials.

- **❖** Trash bags
- Gloves
- **❖** Safety vests
- ❖ Road signs (if necessary)
- Other supplies (as needed)

May we choose which street we want to adopt?

Yes! Groups are encouraged to select a street near their homes, schools or meeting places, that is a minimum length of one mile or the full length of a street or multiple streets.

Groups may select any street and fill out the Adopt-A-Street agreement, in which the street

In addition to clean streets and a sense of pride in serving the community, groups adopting a street will be recognized after each year of service with a plaque by the Mayor and City Council during October. Groups will also be recognized when they join the program through The City of Hendersonville's website.
