**Purpose:** The City Council meeting of November 3, 2016 was continued to Tuesday, November 8, 2016, at 4:30 p.m. at City Hall, to consider the order to close the street.

**1. Call to Order:** Mayor Volk called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. and welcomed those in attendance. A quorum was established with all five members in attendance.

Six members of the public were also in attendance.

**2. Consideration of a Request to Close an Unopened Alley off of Seventh Avenue (continued from November 3, 2016 Meeting):** The public hearing for the street closing was held at the November 3, 2017 meeting of the Council. Mrs. Frady announced an access agreement developed by Mr. Ayers' attorney has been presented to the parties involved. Mrs. Walker stated her attorney has reviewed it and they are in agreement with the access agreement. City Attorney Fritschner stated he reviewed the document and is satisfied it is a recordable document.

Mayor Pro Tem Caraker moved City Council to adopt the Order to Permanently Close a portion of an unnamed alley located off of Seventh Avenue as petitioned by Jonathan Ayers. A unanimous vote of the Council followed; motion carried.
