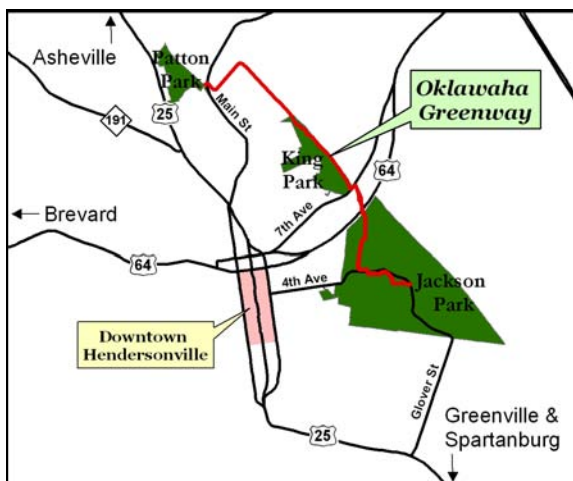

Hendersonville Regional Walking Guide

Walk # 1 of 4: Oklawaha Greenway

Distance: 1.89 miles

Difficulty: The paved trail is relatively flat and is suitable for all ages. Bicycles are encouraged. The trail is handicapped accessible.

Highlights: The Oklawaha Greenway serves as a greenway connector between 3 local parks. For most of its length, the trail follows Mud Creek (also known as Oklawaha Creek). Wetland areas surround the greenway and provide opportunities for wildlife observation. A boardwalk takes the traveler through a wetland area dominated by native trees and shrubs to an observation deck where song birds can often be seen and heard.

Caution: The Greenway crosses 3 public streets and an active railroad grade. Use caution at all crossings!
